<p><b>Removal goods</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Copy of inventory in English.</li> <li>▪ Original BL; in case of express release</li> <li>▪ BL a copy of the BL is required. AWB Copy is fine.</li> <li>▪ Consignee not required for inspection.</li> <li>▪ Although sometimes if the Customs officials find some questionable items at the time of inspection, the client may be called in for an interrogation.</li> <li>▪ Passport copy with residence visa stamped / valid visit visa or a copy of visa application.</li> <li>▪ Import Authorization letter from the client's company for sea shipments and personal authorization letter from the client for air shipments.</li> <li>▪ Client residence address in Muscat prior arrival of shipment in Muscat.</li> </ul>	<p>Oman Customs started E-filing all shipments entering and leaving the country.</p> <p>GAC Oman can register on behalf of its clients, and then pass on log-in details to each shipper to enable them register online and initiate Customs inspection and clearance process.</p> <p>Once preliminary registration is completed, an SMS message or email will be sent to each shipper giving temporary log-in details. Upon receipt of this message, they should visit <a href="https://www.customs.gov.om/portal/en/esw/e-services">https://www.customs.gov.om/portal/en/esw/e-services</a> and follow the steps below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select from list &gt; C00002217 – Mutrah Shipping &amp; Trading Agency LLC</li> <li>6. Select date range for a month</li> <li>7. Save the file and confirm to us</li> </ol> <p>If assistance is required, GAC Oman can assist upon provision of your unique log-in ID and password. If you require such assistance, please send us a mail giving us your log-in details and in the same document state that you authorize us to act for and on your behalf in this regard and proceed with the selection of the clearing agent.</p>	<p>7 days of free storage will be allowed by the customs and port authorities for a full container load, 15 days for LCL and 5 days for air Shipments.</p> <p>All books, literature and audio-visual materials are detained by customs for screening and will be released to the consignee only after approval by the Ministry of Information after 3 – 4 weeks approximately.</p>

<b>Motor vehicles</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Proof of ownership. (vehicle registration papers, purchase receipt, etc.)</li> <li>Passport copy of consignee</li> <li>Original export certificate from origin country (if available)</li> <li>Certificate of Registration copy from the origin country (only left hand drive vehicles are allowed)</li> <li>NOC from sponsor for importation</li> </ul>	Vehicles more than 7 years is not allowed.	<p>Duty between 5% -10%levied on all cars, except for cars/bikes registered after 2003 and moved from within GCC region. However such vehicles should be accompanied by statistical report from country of Origin.</p> <p>New cars must be manufactured to comply with G.C.C. (Gulf Cooperation Council) specifications Confiscation and/or penalties can result from non-compliance with any of the above.</p>
<b>Pets</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Vaccination certificate from health authorities in country of origin.</li> <li>Import permit from Ministry of Agriculture.</li> </ul>	Only pets 4 months and older are allowed.	<p>No quarantine for pets if all documentation requirements are met with.</p> <p>Authorization letter from consignee to clear the pets on his/her behalf.</p>
<b>Prohibited Items</b>		<p>Alcoholic beverages and tobacco products.</p> <p>Pornographic literature, videos, films and pictures (including simple nudity of all kinds).</p> <p>Wireless and communication equipment, including walkie-talkie systems and remote cordless telephones.</p> <p>Political and religious literature need prior approval from the Ministry of Information Drugs and narcotics.</p> <p>Objects made of ivory or any endangered species.</p> <p>Explosives, firearms, ammunition, knives, swords, daggers, spears, etc. (even toy guns and decorative items of this nature are subject to confiscation).</p> <p>Telescopes are not allowed.</p>	<p>ALL MATTER, BOOKS, PICTURES, RECORDS, FILMS, TAPES, SLIDES,MOVIES, VIDEOS, COMPACT DISCS, COMPUTER SOFTWARE, ETC. <p><b>General</b></p>			<p>All prohibited articles detained by customs may be destroyed without the consignee's consent.</p> <p>There are no records available of items destroyed.</p> <p>WOOD PACKAGING (ISPM 15) – FUMIGATION REQUIREMENTS IN OMAN</p> <p>The Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries (Plant Quarantine Department) has advised that effective from 1st January, 2007 the export of any commodity packed in wood with thickness exceeding 6 mm will not be allowed for Export and Import unless they are treated by heat or fumigated by methyl bromide gas and bears the official recognized stamp by the Ministry or the authorized private companies. This requirement also applies to the imported goods to the Sultanate packed in the same wooden material, which shall not be allowed to enter the Sultanate without being similarly treated and bear the recognized official stamp.</p> <p>Therefore, for all export shipments from 1st January 2007 which are packed in wood with thickness exceeding 6 mm should be heat treated or fumigated and packages are stamped as above. The necessary heat treatment/ fumigation certificate should be attached to the Customs Bill of Export before processing. For commodities which are packed in wood with thickness of 6mm or below and or packed in packaging materials other than wood, a declaration from the shipper in their letter head duly signed and stamped should be attached to the Customs Bill of Export before processing. Your agent will also need a copy of the certificate or declaration as the case may be while booking the cargo for export.</p>
